

Merry Christmas 2014 and Happy New Year 2015

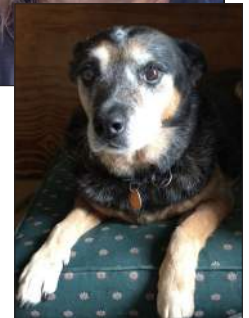
Words cast in a sundial at a picturesque rest area overlooking Chautauqua Lake west of Jamestown, NY reads:
