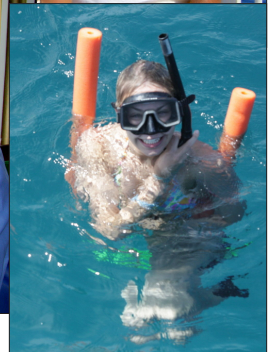
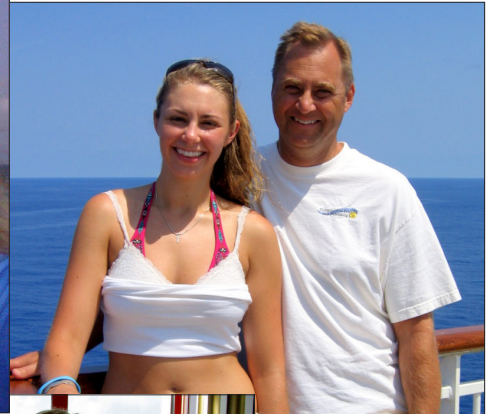


# Corbett Christmas 2010
